Singapore residents aged 13 to 19 years old



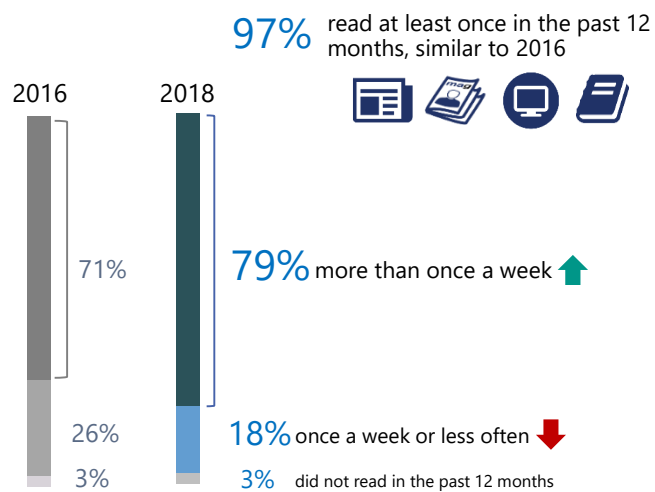

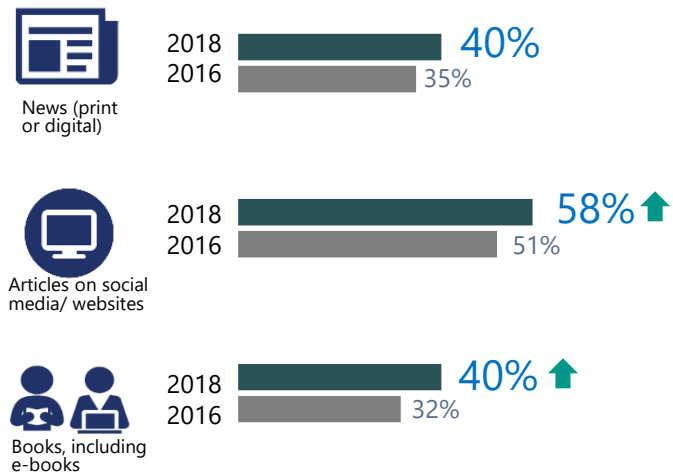
## ARE TEENAGERS READING?

## WHAT ARE TEENAGERS READING?

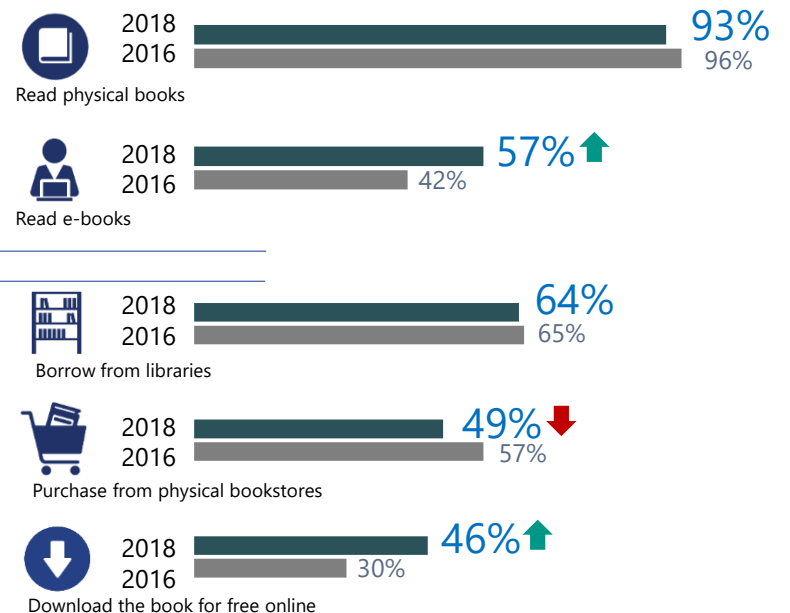
Teenagers read the following more than once a week...

2018 **90%** read at least 1 book in the past 12 months

No change in the ranking of key motivations and barriers in 2018 compared to 2016
